



Secondary supply

Secondary supply of alcohol to young people under the age of 18 is prohibited. This is when an adult supplies alcohol to a minor, or buys alcohol and then gives it to a minor.

The secondary supply laws apply at all times and all venues including homes, halls and parks. The person who supplies the alcohol to the minor is committing a secondary party sale offence and is liable to a maximum penalty of \$5,500 or \$11,000 in serious cases. On the spot fines of \$550 can also be issued by police.
